By the end of the course, you will have a good understanding of the different tools used for data collection and assessment, urban sanitation diagnostic tools and stakeholder analysis. Whether you are a sanitation professional looking to improve access to sanitation services in your community, or a policy maker looking to create more effective sanitation systems, this course will give you the knowledge and skills to succeed.
